Thank you for your initial submission, which we started to process on May 21, 2020. We have reviewed your plans and attached our comments along with this cover letter. The first section of our review highlights our major comments. The following sections contain more specific comments, including those received from other city departments and community members.

Since several important issues remain, you will need to make another submission. Please revise your previous work and send us a new submission on or before June 22, 2020.

After seeing that there were no red lines or clouded areas on the plan, I contacted Tiffany Watson to get updated plans. Unfortunately, some of the team members had already reviewed the proposal, so I decided not to switch out the drawings to minimize confusion. Make sure the second submission has a delta 1 on the cover sheet with a description of the amendment and be sure to highlight the changes throughout the document.

Note that all our comments are numbered. When you resubmit, include a cover letter specifically responding to each item. The Planning Department reserves the right to reject any resubmissions that fail to address these items. If you have made any other changes to your documents other than those requested, be sure to also specifically list them in your letter.
