KMGG will not be constructing any above-ground appurtenances along the route of this pipeline project (the AGAs constructed within the existing Wattenberg Plant and the Mustang Booster Station that is being constructed).



During construction, KMGG will place portable toilets at a ratio of one per every ten people near the location of the crew. These portable toilets will be cleaned once a week and moved with the crew to ensure accessibility and availability for maintenance. Additionally, KMGG will utilize two dumpsters for the disposal of materials throughout the duration of the project.
