The mission for the public art within the Lamar Landing Master Plan is to enhance the visual appearance of the public spaces and to engage all age groups of the community.

GENERAL LOCATION:
The public art will be located within Planning Area 8. The artwork will be located within this public space to encourage pedestrian access in which the artwork can be an interactive piece for the community.

TIMING & INSTALLATION:
The timing of installation for public art within this Master Plan will depend on the CSP approval process and the (PIP) Public Improvement Plan. When the site plan process for Planning Area 8 is underway, it will include information about the nature, location, materials, and theme for the public art.
