1A. The Site Plan will not be approved by Public Works until the Preliminary Drainage Report is approved.

1B. How are the interim Picadilly improvements south of 38th being coordinated?

1C. The City will accept a variance for swale slope but please add the note provided on sheet C-9 for the proposed temporary swales and state the specific entity that will be responsible for maintenance.

2. Traffic Engineering (Brianna Medema / 303-739-7336 / bmedema@auroragov.org / Comments in amber)

2A. We are concerned about the southbound through lane geometry at the Picadilly intersection (no more than 6' offset allowed, 0 offset desired). The southbound left turn conflict with northbound left turns. Has this been looked at? Please reference Sheet C-7.

2B. As the interim condition is right or left only, why not have a single chevron only, and remove striping on one side? See Sheet C-9.

3. Real Property (Maurice Brooks / 303-739-7294 / mbrooks@auroragov.org / Comments in magenta)

3A. Add labels as shown on the redlines.

3B. Add adjacent plat references or add "Unplatted" where applicable.

3C. The easement and right-of-way dedications by separate document must be complete prior to recordation.
