This Contextual Site Plan Amendment proposal is for the addition of landscape materials within the center median of Powhaton Road, between the intersections of East Arapahoe Road and East Southshore Parkway. Landscape elements proposed include ornamental grasses, shrubs, and trees. The landscape design of this portion of the median section will reflect the same planting palate and design as the median section of Powhaton Road directly to the south. By including this additional median landscape the Powhaton Road streetscape will be a complete and cohesive element of the Southshore community.
