



## PRELIMINARY THEME

In acknowledgment of the light-rail station directly across the street, the Public Art will be oriented to the west and provide passersby and residents with a visually-intriguing and potentially interactive offering. Considerations include:

- A mural on the east-facing retaining walls of the detention pond along Abilene
- A sculptural element incorporated into the SW corner of the building architecture
- A single or series of sculptures located at the W of the site near the entry plaza space

## PRELIMINARY SCHEDULE

- Calls for entry will begin Q2 - Q3 of 2022
- Selection and design process will run concurrently with Aurora Entitlements Process
- Art implementation will begin after supportive and adjacent construction is completed, est. 2023

## MATERIALS

Materials for Public Art are to coordinate with materials and modern aesthetic style of architecture. The building materials will include a mix of metal, concrete, wood and masonry. We envision any sculptural art to use durable materials such as metal and concrete. The style should be abstract and/or contemporary. The work(s) could be done by one Artist or an Artist Team. The incorporation of light for all of the art pieces is very important.
