- 6B. Because both streets are required to meet the curbside landscape requirements and may not have sod, provide the square footage of curbside landscaping for each street as well as the required and provided shrub totals. One shrub per 40 sf of curbside landscape.
- 6C. Code requires a variety of plant material in terms of height, color and width. Only one shrub species is proposed with the N. Gun Club Road street frontage.
- 6D. A tree is required at the terminis of every parking row and will help provide shade to the employee break area.
- 6E. Building perimeter landscaping must occur on the east face and is still not being met.
- 6F. Update the landscape tables where indicated.
- 6G. This island does not satisfy the building perimeter requirement, but does meet the requirement to terminate each parking row with a tree.
